SYNOPSIS

SELFISH

40 humanitarian workers and their loved ones confide straightforwardly

War, emergency, pandemics and hunger. Humanitarian workers are used to working in the most varied and extreme missions and contexts across the planet.

However, few of them venture openly into the world of personal feelings. For this film, forty humanitarian workers and their loved ones did just that, speaking without reserve about the risk, the commitment, the first mission, the sense of powerlessness, the encounters, the passion, the return home and the unspeakable things they've witnessed.

This film, which is logically about humanitarian workers' commitment to other people, also explores the question of their selfishness in choosing to do this kind of work. Each person, in their own words, tells us about their feelings and experiences. Openly and straightforwardly, they tell us who they are and speak of their commitment to others, their doubts, their weaknesses and the images that haunt them.

In this film, the humanitarians are not the only ones to bear witness - the women and men who share their private and personal lives also tell their stories. The result is an original and intimate documentary that provides a fascinating insight into the inner worlds of humanitarian workers both in the field and away from the action.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE OF INTENT

There are many stories about humanitarian action as it has played out in the recent history of certain countries; stories at the heart of the action, in a specific context, often linked to high-visibility events (such as Syria and the Ebola crisis). News images where natural disasters or war become the norm. In the midst of these images, humanitarian workers are on the front line speaking out, providing care and helping those in need.

For this film, we have chosen to break the usual codes of those reports, as they have already been seen so many times. Instead, we put the same questions to a large number of humanitarian workers and their loved ones; we invited them to talk about themselves, their convictions, their doubts, their weaknesses, their fears and their decision to get involved in this kind of work.

We chose to make humanitarian engagement and what it entails the central theme.

This film is different in the way it is both structured and written in that it is composed of interviews conducted out of the spotlight, away from the action. Many people had the opportunity to share their experiences, to talk about the fates they chose for themselves, or that befell them. The intimate interviews are supported by footage from the field, vividly showing the world as it is.

This documentary is also its title. SELFISH is challenging. Only listening to oneself in order to help others could be perceived by some as an egotistical approach, like any other decision regarding a life choice or a course of action.

Stéphane Santini has worked on projects related to sustainable development, humanitarian action, medical research, sport, the environment and heritage, and for many years has specialised in social and health-related themes.
